- Communicate our environmental issues and performances with our stakeholders and employees.
- Preserve and enhance the current environmental performance.
- Working collaboratively with stakeholders to positively impact the environmental issues.
- Understanding the strengths and opportunities within our supply chain to ensure that we utilise it to minimise the environmental impacts arising out of our activities.
- Reducing environmental damage caused by use of resources.
- To protect the environment including the prevention of pollution by the implementation of effective precautions, monitoring systems and prompt action where necessary.
